

Dear US Junior Hunter National Championships Competitor,

Welcome to the 2019 US Junior Hunter National Championship-East Coast. We are very happy to have you here. Please let us know if there is anything we can do to make your experience here more enjoyable.

- **If you are not entered and competing in the Brandywine Horse Shows, we request that you do not lunge, ride or exercise your horse until after the show day in the Wheeler Ring has been completed on Saturday, July 6.**
- **If you are not entered and competing in the Brandywine Horse Shows we request that you do not lunge, ride or exercise your horse on Sunday, July 7 after 7:00 AM until the show days are completed in both the Dixon Oval and Wheeler Ring.**
- Below is a schedule of available ride times and lunging times for Junior Hunter Finals entries:

WARMUPS, SUNDAY, JULY 7

- Groups of 5 horses will have 4 minutes to school
- All jumps must be jumped in the direction in which they are set, but do not have to be jumped in any particular order
- Second rounds will be permitted only after all competitors have schooled once, and only if time permits
- Riders must check in with the starters prior to participating
- Back number must be worn during warmups
- Any potential replacement equitation horses must be entered and possess a (black) competition back number
- After 7:30 PM only the competition rider may ride horses (see page 9 or 10 in prize list)

SUNDAY, MONDAY, TUESDAY

- Both rings open for flatting until one half hour prior to start of show
- Lunging in main schooling area & lunging pad one half hour prior to start of show
